If we say	We have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness	We lie and do not practice the truth
But if	We walk in the light as he is in the light	We have fellowship with one another and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin
If we say	We have no sin	We deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us
If	We confess our sins	He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness
If we say	We have not sinned	We make him a liar and his word is not in us
But if	Anyone does sin	we have an advocate with the father, Jesus Christ the righteous
